

MexBS Tiered Coupons v1.1.1 User Guide for Magento 2

Welcome to the MexBs family, and thank you for purchasing the "Tiered Coupons" magento extension! In this document we will guide you through the installation steps, and show you how to use and get the maximum from your extension.

Important: This user guide is for **Magento 2**. If you are working on Magento 1, please read *MI-MexBs Tiered Coupons v101 User Guide.pdf*

Installation

Before we begin, please ensure that you have a backup of your data before proceeding with the installation of the extension. This is because although we will make our best to support you, we cannot take responsibility of any data loss that might occur during the installation/adjustments of this extension.

- [1] Unpack the Mexbs_Tieredcoupon_v1.1.1.zip file.
- [2] Go to Mexbs_Tieredcoupon_v1.1.1/extension_files. Open up the directory that corresponds to your Magento version. For instance, if your Magento version is 2.1.1, open up Mexbs_Tieredcoupon_v1.1.1-CE-2.1.x-2.3.x. Copy the content of this directory into your Magento installation directory.
- [3] Connect via SSH and go to your Magento root directory
- [4] Determine the mode that your Magento is running on, by running the following command:

```
php bin/magento deploy:mode:show
```

- [5] If you are in **developer** or **default** mode, run the following commands:

```
php bin/magento module:enable Mexbs_Tieredcoupon --clear-static-content  
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

If your Magento version is 2.0.x or 2.1.x run:

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

If your Magento version is 2.2.x or 2.3.x run:

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f
```

- [6] If you are in **production** mode, run the following commands:

```
php bin/magento module:enable Mexbs_Tieredcoupon --clear-static-content  
php bin/magento setup:upgrade  
php bin/magento setup:di:compile  
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

- [7] Go to the admin panel – “System->Cache Management” and click “Flush Magento Cache”.

Creating your first Tiered Coupon

In this tutorial, we will create the following tiered coupon:

- On subtotal of **50\$-100\$** get **10%** discount
- On subtotal of **100\$-200\$** get **25%** discount
- On subtotal of **200\$ or more** get **30%** discount

Step 1: Creating 3 regular coupons

In the admin panel, go to "Marketing → Cart Price Rules".

Create the "On subtotal of 50\$-100\$ get 10% discount" coupon:

- Rule name: On subtotal of 50\$-100\$ get 10% discount
- Status: Active
- Websites: The websites which you want your coupon to be active in.
- Customer Groups: The customer groups which you want your coupon to be active for.
- Coupon: Specific Coupon
- Coupon Code: subtotal-50-100-10
- Priority: 3
- Conditions:

Apply the rule only if the following conditions are met (leave blank for all products).

If ALL of these conditions are TRUE :

Subtotal equals or greater than 50 

Subtotal less than 100

Apply the rule only to cart items matching the following conditions (leave blank for all items).

Create the "On subtotal of 100\$-200\$ get 25% discount" coupon:

- Rule name: On subtotal of 100\$-200\$ get 25% discount
- Status: Active
- Websites: The websites which you want your coupon to be active in.
- Customer Groups: The customer groups which you want your coupon to be active for.
- Coupon: Specific Coupon
- Coupon Code: subtotal-100-200-25
- Priority: 2
- Conditions:

Apply the rule only if the following conditions are met (leave blank for all products).

If ALL of these conditions are TRUE :

Subtotal equals or greater than 100 ✖

Subtotal less than 200 ✖

Free Shipping

Apply the rule only to cart items matching the following conditions (leave blank for all items).

If ALL of these conditions are TRUE :



Save it.

Create the "On subtotal of 200\$ or higher get 30% discount" coupon:

- Rule name: On subtotal of 200\$ or higher get 30% discount
- Status: Active
- Websites: The websites which you want your coupon to be active in.
- Customer Groups: The customer groups which you want your coupon to be active for.
- Coupon: Specific Coupon
- Coupon Code: subtotal-200-30
- Priority: 1
- Conditions:

Apply the rule only if the following conditions are met (leave blank for all products).

If ALL of these conditions are TRUE :

Subtotal equals or greater than 200

Apply the rule only to cart items matching the following conditions (leave blank for all items).

If ALL of these conditions are TRUE :



Save it.

Notes:

- The "Rule name" and the "Coupon code" values are not essential. That is, you can give any name/coupon code you want (but not empty ones).
- Priority is the order in which the coupons are applied. That is, once the tiered coupon is applied, it will try to apply those 3 coupons one by one, and the order of the application will be determined by the "Priority" field.

Step 2: Creating the tiered coupon

Go to "Marketing → Tiered Coupons".
Click "Add New Tiered Coupon".

In the top form, fill the following values:

- Name: Crazy Summer Promotion
- Code: crazy-summer
- Active: Yes

In the "Manage Sub Coupons" section, choose the 3 previously created coupons:

Click "Save".

You are done!!

Note: The "Name" and the "Code" fields' values are not essential. That is, you can give any name/code you want (but not empty ones).

The description field is not essential, that is it is only for your internal usage and can remain empty.

Step 3: Testing the tiered coupon

To test the newly created tiered coupon, go to the frontend.

Add some products to the card, such that subtotal will be 50 or higher.

Apply the coupon "crazy-summer" in the cart.

You should get the correct discount according to your subtotal.

How does it work?

The "Tiered Coupon" extension is built to combine other coupons.

This is very simple and powerful concept.

That is, once the tiered coupon is applied, it tries to apply its children coupons one by one. The order of the application of the children coupons will be determined by their "Priority" field. If the child coupon is "Inactive", it won't be applied. If one of the successfully applied children coupons has the field "Stop Further Rules Processing" equals to "Yes", the tiered coupon will stop and won't try to apply the other children coupons.

Inactivating the tiered coupon

You can inactivate the tiered coupon by changing its "Active" field to "No" and saving it.

Mass-generating tiered coupon codes

Note: This feature is currently available only for Magento 2.2.x and 2.3.x versions.

The extension allows mass-generating codes for a tiered coupon. To do that, go to the tiered coupon in the admin panel, and scroll down to the “Auto-generate Coupon Codes” tab. Click on the tab, you should get the following screen –

The table is currently empty, showing '0 records found' and a message 'We couldn't find any records.'

Note: you need to save the tiered coupon at least once, before being able to mass generate the codes.

Fill in the fields and click “Generate”. You should be able to see the auto generated coupon codes in the grid below.

Fields explanation

- **Coupon Qty** – number of the coupon codes that you want to generate
- **Code Length** – the length of each generated code
- **Code Format** – **Alphanumeric** – letters and numbers / **Alphabetical** - only letters / **Numeric** – only numbers
- **Code Prefix** – a string that will be appended in the beginning of each code
- **Code Suffix** – a string that will be appended in the end of each code

- **Dash Every X Characters** – if this field is higher than 0, the extension will put a dash on the coupon code every X characters

Example

Our fields are filled as the following: **Coupon Qty = 10, Code Length = 16, Code Format = Alphanumeric, Code Prefix = xmas_, Code Suffix = _promo, Dash Every X Characters = 4**

We click the “Generate” button, and here is what we get in the coupon codes grid –

The behavior of the auto-generated tiered coupon codes

When the customer applies the mass generated code in the cart, the extension applies the discount logic of the associated tiered coupon. If the tiered coupon is disabled, its auto generated codes won't work.
